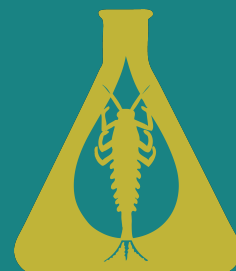




Volunteer Water Quality Monitoring Training

Join a network of thousands of citizen scientists collecting biological, chemical, and physical assessment data on Missouri's wadable streams. Training is free and certified monitors will receive equipment to collect stream flow, biological, and chemical data.

Level 1* Training Opportunities

Spring 2024

Certification requires completion of virtual training *and* a streamside field training. There are no pre-requisites or costs to attend the Level 1 training.

Step 1. Virtual training

Complete all Level 1 training videos to be eligible to attend the streamside field certification. These are self-paced and can be watched anytime.

Step 2. Streamside field certification

During the field certification, you will practice monitoring methods at a stream site under the direction of Stream Team staff. Locations of these trainings include St. Louis, Kansas City, Central and Southwest Missouri. Registration closes one week prior to the training.
