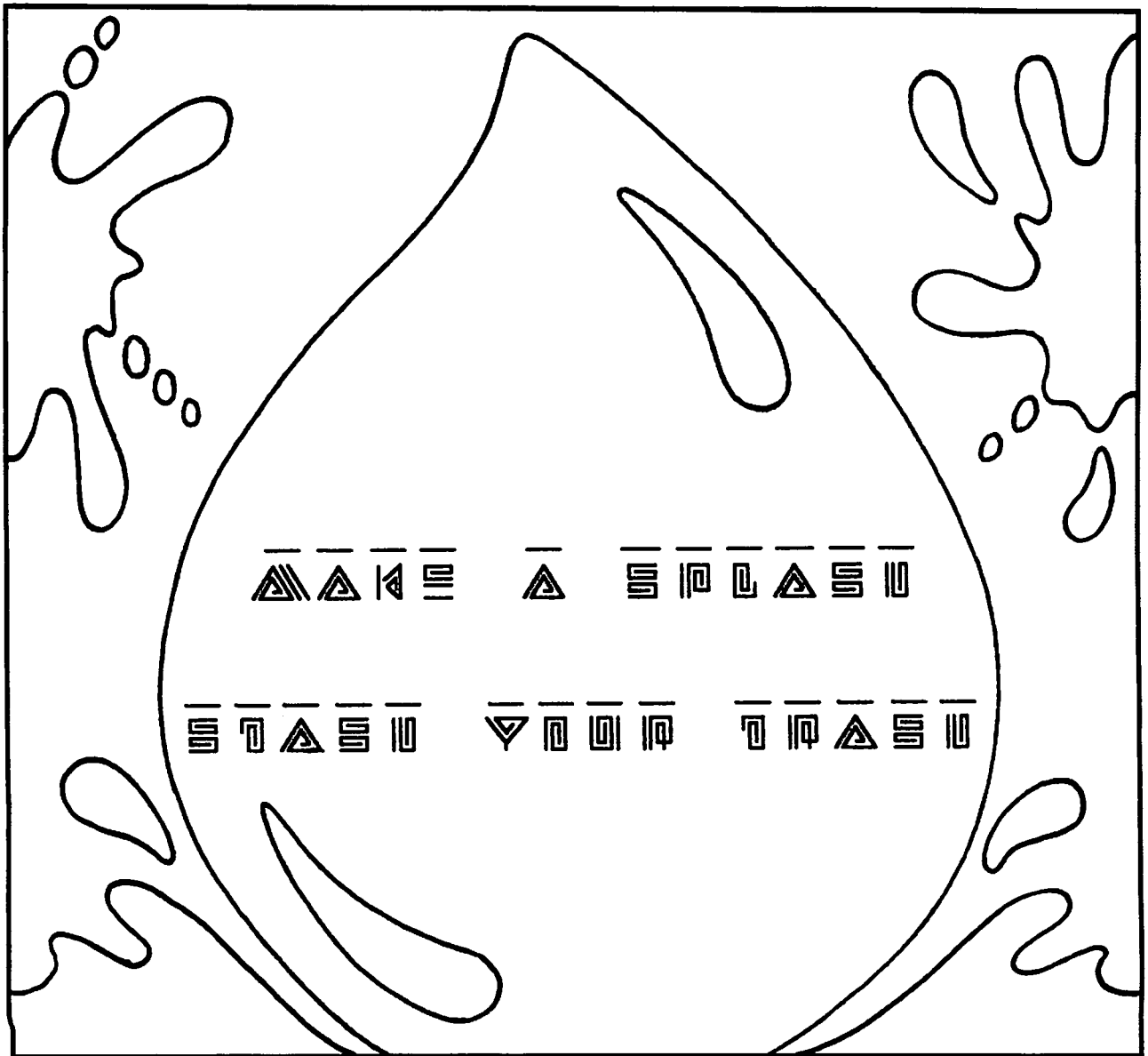


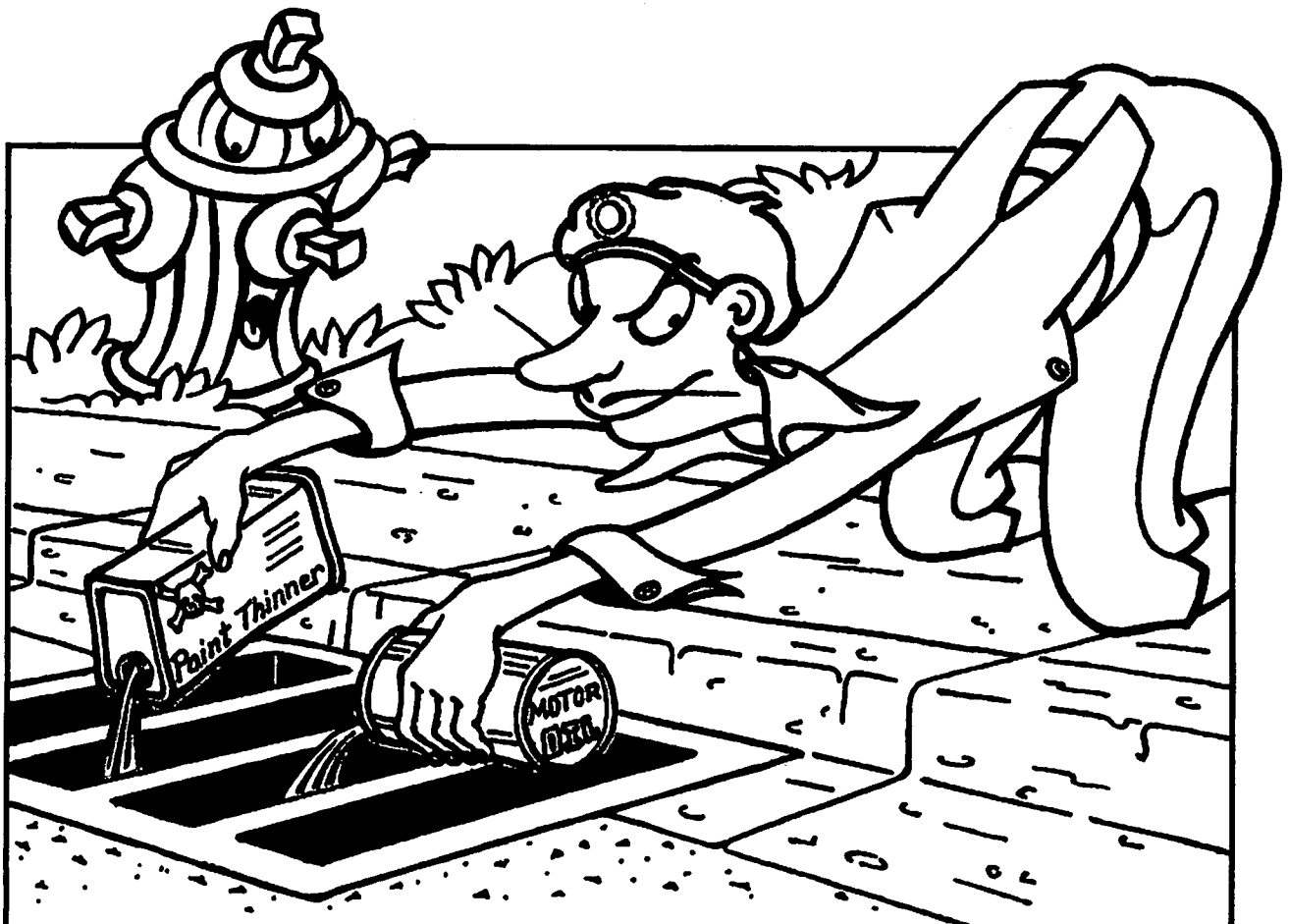
Sloppy Polly Polluter leaves a trail of trash and garbage everywhere she goes. What will happen to Stream Team Creek if she doesn't stop littering?

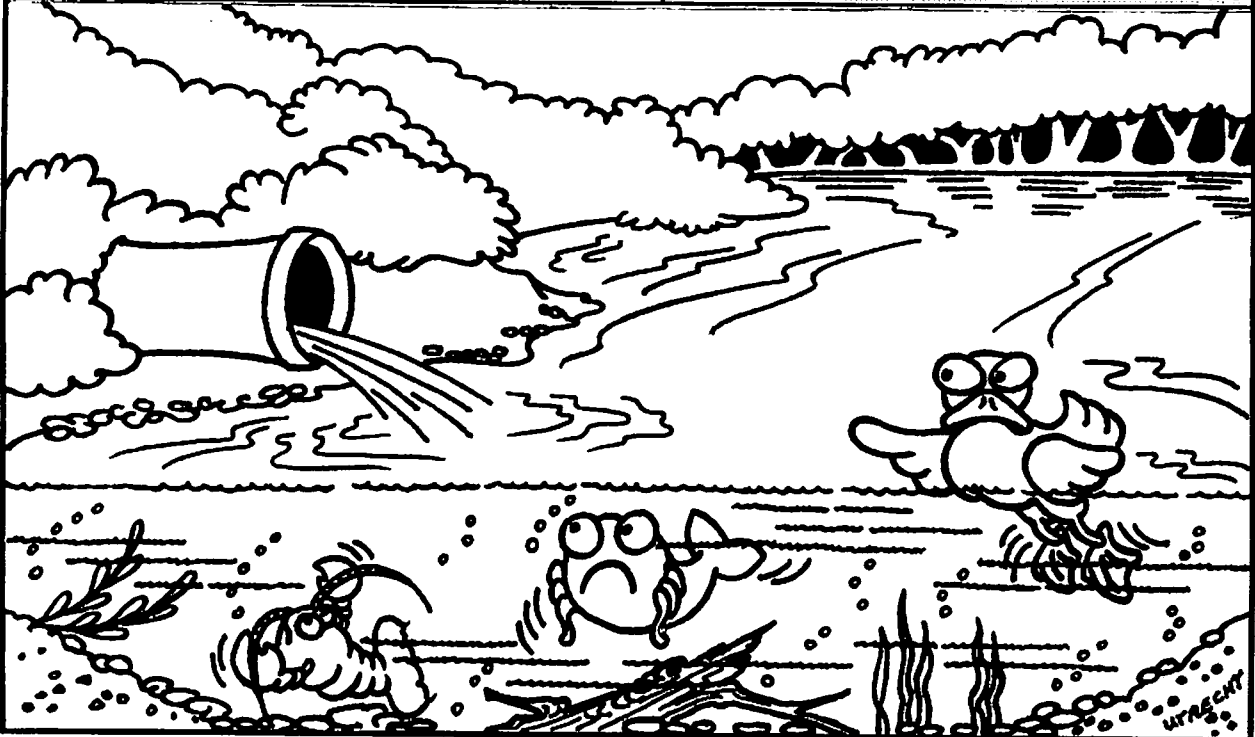

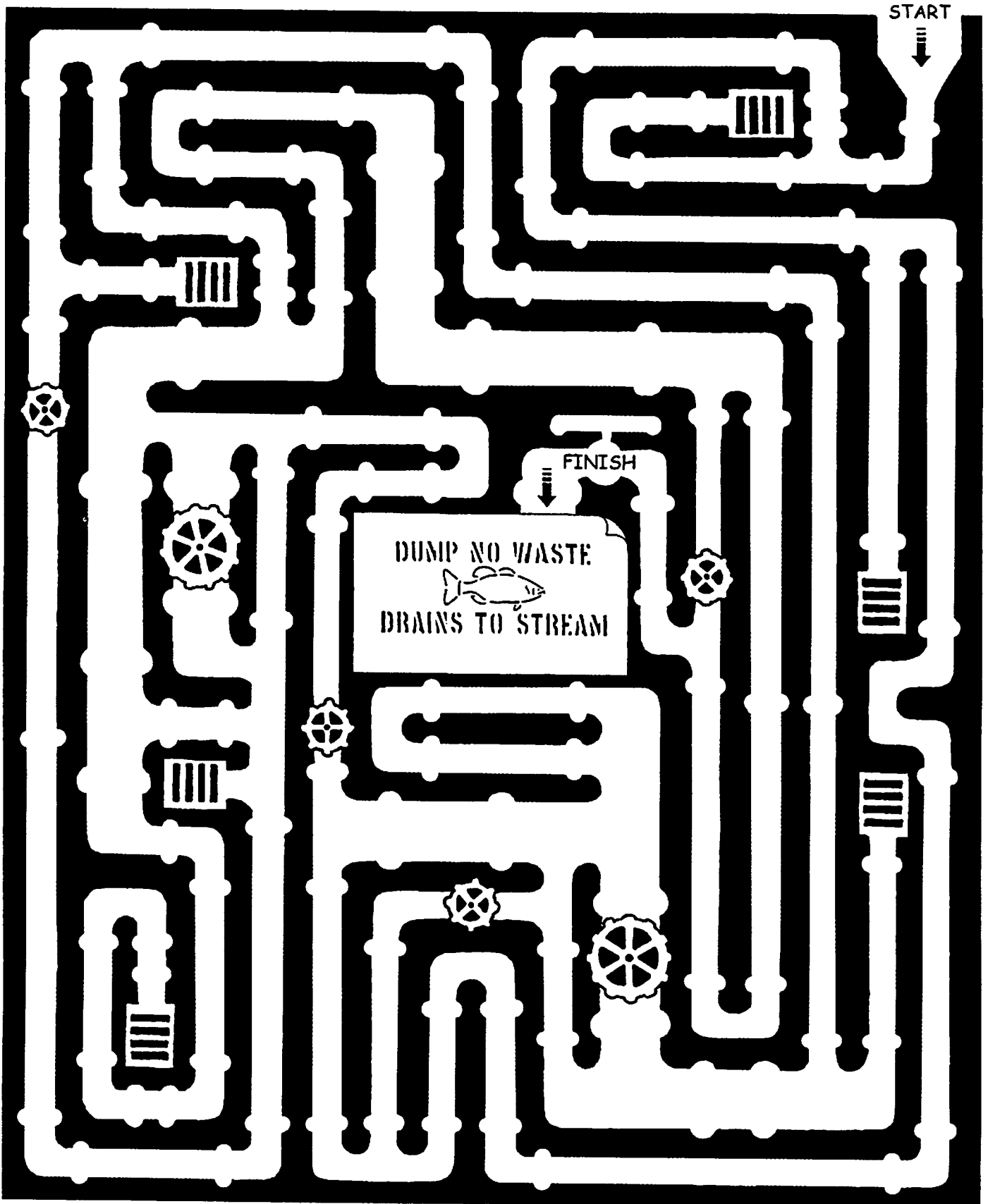


DUMP NO WASTE.  DRAINS TO STREAM!

## Can you teach Bull E. Dozer about these healthy stream words?

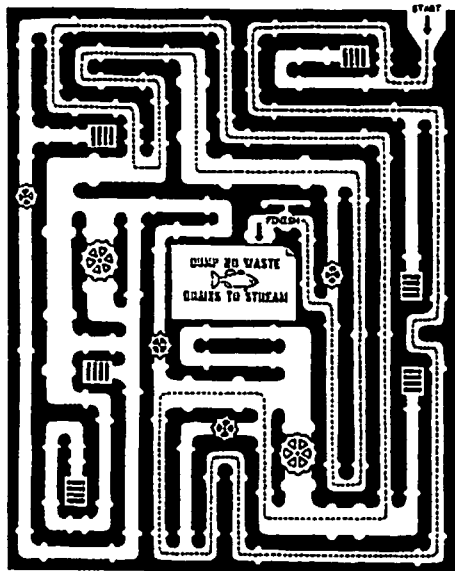
1. WATERSHED -- Healthy watersheds have forests and plants to prevent soil erosion.
2. RIPARIAN ZONE -- Trees & plants in this 100' wide zone create healthy streams.
3. STREAM BANKS -- Banks covered with trees and shrubs are strong and stable.
4. FLOODPLAINS -- Low areas of land are needed for the overflow of flood water.
5. STREAM CHANNEL -- It's best to let a stream channel flow and meander naturally.
6. HABITAT -- Stream riffles, pools, and trees provide shelter for fish and wildlife.
7. WETLANDS -- Areas covered with shallow water are good habitat for waterfowl.
8. WATER QUALITY -- Good water quality is needed for wildlife, industry, and fun.
9. STREAM TEAM -- Can you adopt a stream today? Form a Missouri Stream Team!

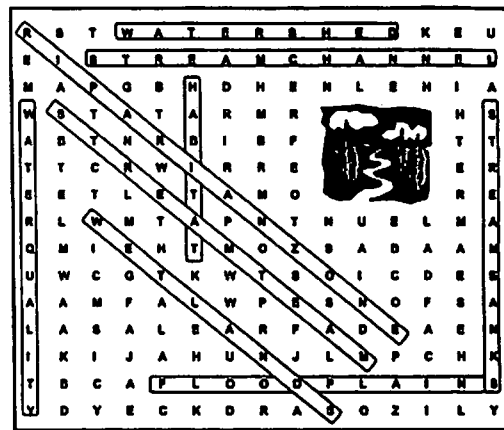
